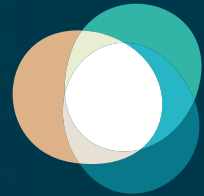

Established as an initiative of the Indonesian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KADIN) in 2015, CRU evolved into CRU Indonesia in 2024 to expand its strategic role in responding to conflicts and strengthening stakeholder capacity for long-term solutions. Today, more than 50 members with diverse backgrounds and expertise work together to advance the organization's mission.

CRU Indonesia is a non-profit organization that promotes fair, inclusive, and sustainable natural resource governance by strengthening systems for addressing land and natural resource conflicts.

We advocate for a collaborative, dialogic, and evidence-based conflict-sensitive approach to conflict resolution..

Capacity Building

Providing capacity-building services for government, the private sector, civil society, and local communities. Training programs are designed in a participatory and contextual manner based on field needs.

Actively developing and disseminating knowledge on land and natural resource conflicts to support evidence-based policymaking and interventions.

Providing advisory services to develop recommendations tailored to partners' needs, supported by assessment processes specifically designed according to each partner's objectives.

Kepenasihatan dan Konsultasi


Actively facilitating conflict resolution, either as a neutral third party directly conducting mediation between stakeholders or as a supporting institution in mediation processes.

Audit dan Tinjau-ulang Sistem

Providing support for reviewing conflict management systems or initiatives developed by governments and businesses to ensure they function as intended and remain relevant..

CAPACITY BUILDING

Capacity development for government, private sector, civil society, and local communities designed in a participatory and context-specific manner




Conflict Documentation and Reporting Training

- Training for national and local government staff in identifying, documenting, and reporting tenure and natural resource conflicts.
- Strengthening conflict information systems through standardized reporting templates.



Human Rights Due Diligence (HRDD)

- Workshops and technical guidance on HRDD implementation in forestry, agribusiness, and energy sectors.
- Training modules covering human rights risk identification, mitigation, and remediation.



Certified Mediator Training

- Facilitation of nationally recognized mediator certification programs endorsed by the Supreme Court of Indonesia.
- Training in mediation techniques, interest-based negotiation, and multi-stakeholder management in natural resource contexts.

KNOWLEDGE MANAGEMENT

Development and dissemination of knowledge on land and natural resource conflicts to support evidence-based policy and interventions

Knowledge Dissemination and Learning

- Policy outreach and communication
- Publication of a monthly e-newsletter, *Layang Damai*, covering land and natural resource conflict issues in Indonesia.
- Monthly webinar series *Seka Sengketa*, a digital platform for knowledge sharing in collaboration with TMSHare, featuring expert speakers

Case and Policy Studies

- Sectoral and regional conflict studies, including analysis of root causes, actors, and power dynamics
- Policy studies on social forestry, agrarian reform, and recognition of Indigenous peoples' rights.

Development of Indicative Conflict-Prone Area Maps

- GIS-based mapping of high-risk conflict areas for conflict mitigation planning .
- Collaboration with local governments and stakeholders for field data validation.



LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCE CONFLICT RESOLUTION

Actively facilitating conflict resolution either as a neutral third party conducting mediation or as a supporting institution in mediation processes.

Technical Assistance to Government and Stakeholders

Providing technical support to government institutions in handling land and natural resource conflicts and strengthening institutional capacity

Multi-Stakeholder Collaboration

Partnerships with ministries/agencies, companies, civil society, and donors to develop sustainable conflict documentation systems, grievance mechanisms, and response systems.

Neutral and Impartial Conflict Handling

- Case assessments as part of conflict resolution processes
- Mediation between companies, communities, and government in agrarian and forestry conflicts
- Facilitation of conflict resolution roadmaps, agreement formulation, and implementation monitoring

ADVISORY AND CONSULTANCY

To support the resolution of land and natural resource conflicts in Indonesia, CRU provides advisory services tailored to partners' needs.

Tailored Assessment Processes

- Due diligence on compliance with the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights (UNGPs)
- Assessment of effectiveness and responsiveness of grievance mechanisms related to corporate sustainability policies
- Development of grievance mechanisms as early conflict response systems
- Studies and recommendations on alleged land and natural resource conflicts



SYSTEM AUDIT AND REVIEW

Providing support to review conflict management systems or initiatives developed by governments and businesses to ensure effectiveness and continued relevance.

Audit and Review Services

- Audit and review of policies and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) related to UNGPs and corporate sustainability policies
- Audit and review of grievance mechanisms and conflict resolution systems

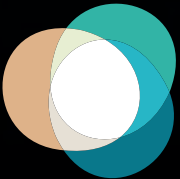

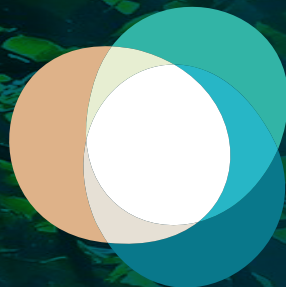
